## IMPLOSION AT NHIT, 8 MISSING

Early Saturday morning, between 7:30 and 7:35am an ear-splitting burst rang out across the NHT campus, reported by witnesses as far as five miles away. In the aftermath, much of the Applied Physics Laboratory, including the cryophysics lab had disappeared.

"Disappeared" is the most appropriate word, because according to multiple witnesses the lab and the surrounding area were simply *gone* after the deafening noise.

A perfect sphere of destruction, centered on the cryophysics lab, approximately 60 meters (2000t) across marred the Northern edge of campus, slicing through the laboratory, the engineering workshop, and the library, revealing interior rooms of heavy brick and concrete buildings.

Not long after the event the channel 5 news helicopter took off, hoping for a better view. Upon landing in Keene at 10:30, they were greeted by the military, who confiscated their footage.

The same thing happened to our own reporters, they were detained and had their film and equipment taken by National Guardsmen citing the Extraordinary Materials Act. Other publications describe similar treatment.

Not long after the military arrived, they

started reinforcing the sagging laboratory and covered the enormous hole in tarps. More military equipment arrived throughout the day and night and the campus has been shut down for the foreseeable future, leading to hundreds of students seeking alternate accommodations elsewhere.


In the midst of all this chaos, eight people are unaccounted for, a number that may increase. It is a cold comfort that this disaster happened when it did, a weekday would have seen hundreds of missing students and faculty.

Among the missing are Erich Schild, a wellliked researcher and head of the physics department (above left). Floyd Carter (above right), a rising star with major contributions to high temperature superconductors, and Diane Braddock, a graduate student (not pictured).

Other names have yet to be released.

The steadily increasing military presence, and the invocation of the Extraordinary Materials Act implies the existence of exotic science and secretive discoveries, after its most famous use during the Selene-Voskhod incident. However, according to school records the only military adjacent research is a NACA contract for electric spacecraft propulsion, currently delayed due to leaks in the vacuum chamber.
